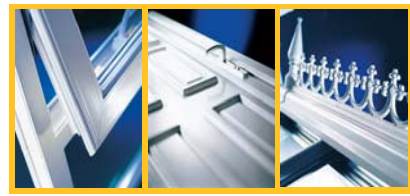

- **Victorian** - the most popular style due to its suitability for most house styles. The Victorian style is available in a choice of three or five facet with a bay front.
- **Georgian** - the flat fronted style offers excellent use of floor space as it features a square or rectangular floor space. A contemporary style is created as each side of the roof slopes back to the centre.
- **Gable** - offers excellent use of internal space as the high sloped roof creates a feeling of great height within the conservatory
- **Lean-To** - suitable for lower pitched properties as the pitch of the roof is adjustable.

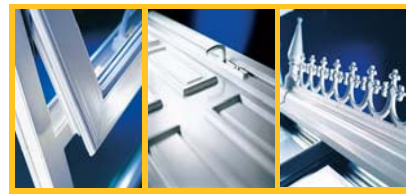


And something different

- Various roofing options are offered in contemporary and traditional styles
- Colour choices include White, Oak, Mahogany and Rosewood
- Glazing options include polycarbonate in a range of colours, thicknesses and specifications - clear, opal, bronze, bronze opal and heatguard opal or glass options

A range of options are available

Decorative Strips - classic designs are available to give each conservatory a personal touch, easy to install they simply “click” into place.

Choose from Tudor, Fern, Tapestry and Majestic available in white, oak and mahogany.

Ventilation Strip - Creating ventilation as low down as possible is desirable to create a cross-flow of air. The Ventilation Strip is ideal in providing cross-flow ventilation and aiding the natural convection currents by which air circulates in a conservatory

Roof options include self cleaning glass, basically the same as conventional glass except for a unique dual action coating. The glass helps to save energy and reduces heat loss by up to 45%. A U value can be achieved of 1.2 and it is available in subtle blue.
