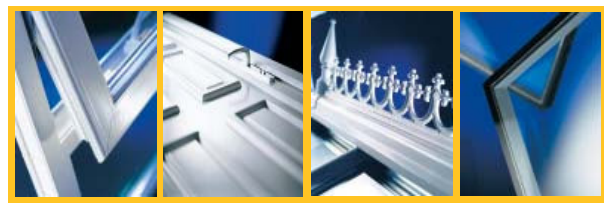

- **Colour Range:** White, Oak or Mahogany

- **Convenience:** Moving parts within the door simply require a light oiling once or twice a year to ensure that the patio doors continue to side open smoothly
- **Safety:** Fully glazed doors fitted with safety glass. This ensures that the glass will not shatter should an accident occur
- **Low Maintenance:** They will not rot, warp or require repainting
- **Internally Glazed:** An extra security feature as the glass can only be removed from inside your home
- **Security:** The patio doors slide on the outside with anti-locking devices fitted as standard
- **Thermal Efficiency:** Now available with 28mm beading in white, oak, mahogany and rosewood. 28mm beading accommodates a larger 28mm glazing unit
- **Life Expectancy:** The profile used on the patio doors has an estimated life expectancy of 25 years

Where space is limited a patio door is ideal, as the door slides open to one side instead of opening into your living space.
